EpiC receives COVID-19 funding to prevent, prepare for, respond to and bolster health systems to address COVID-19 and reduce cases of re-emergence. Part of EpiC's COVID-19 program is to provide high-quality medical oxygen systems. FHI360 is the prime implementing partner for EpiC.
